

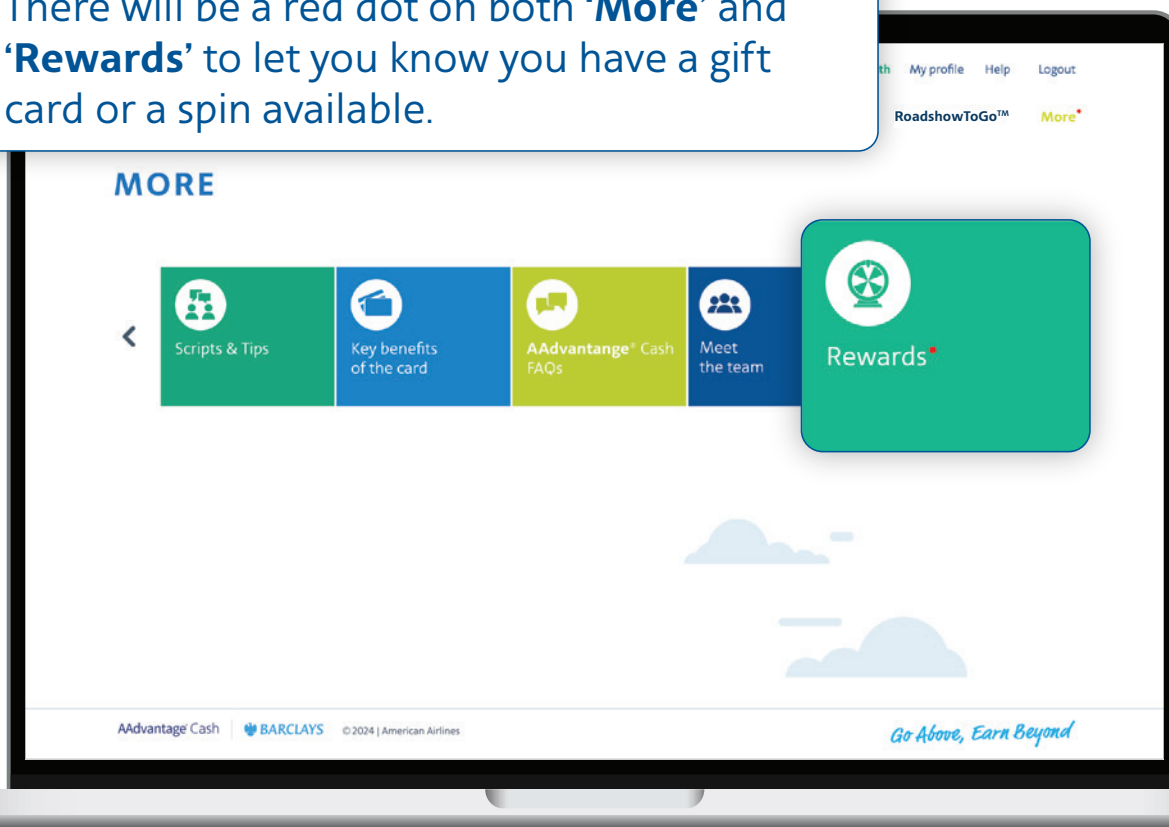

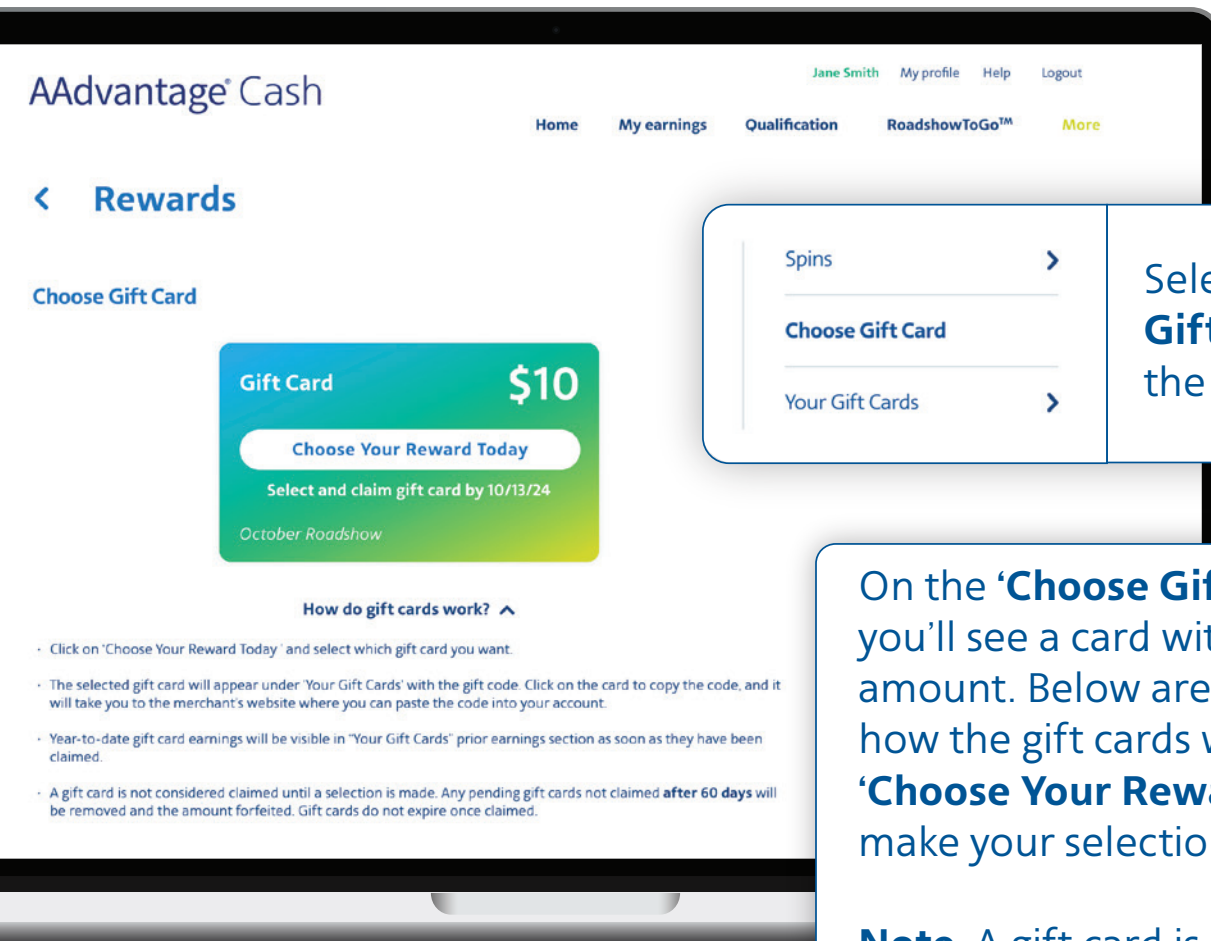
Gift card rewards from roadshows and RoadshowToGo™

To Get Started:

- There will be a red dot on both **'More'** and **'Rewards'** to let you know you have a gift card or a spin available.

Select the '**Choose Gift Card**' tab from the side tab menu.

On the '**Choose Gift Card**' page, you'll see a card with your reward amount. Below are instructions on how the gift cards work. Click on '**Choose Your Reward Today**' to make your selection.

Note: A gift card is not considered claimed until a selection is made. Any pending gift cards not claimed after **60** days from the time of receiving will be removed and the amount forfeited. Gift cards do not expire once claimed.

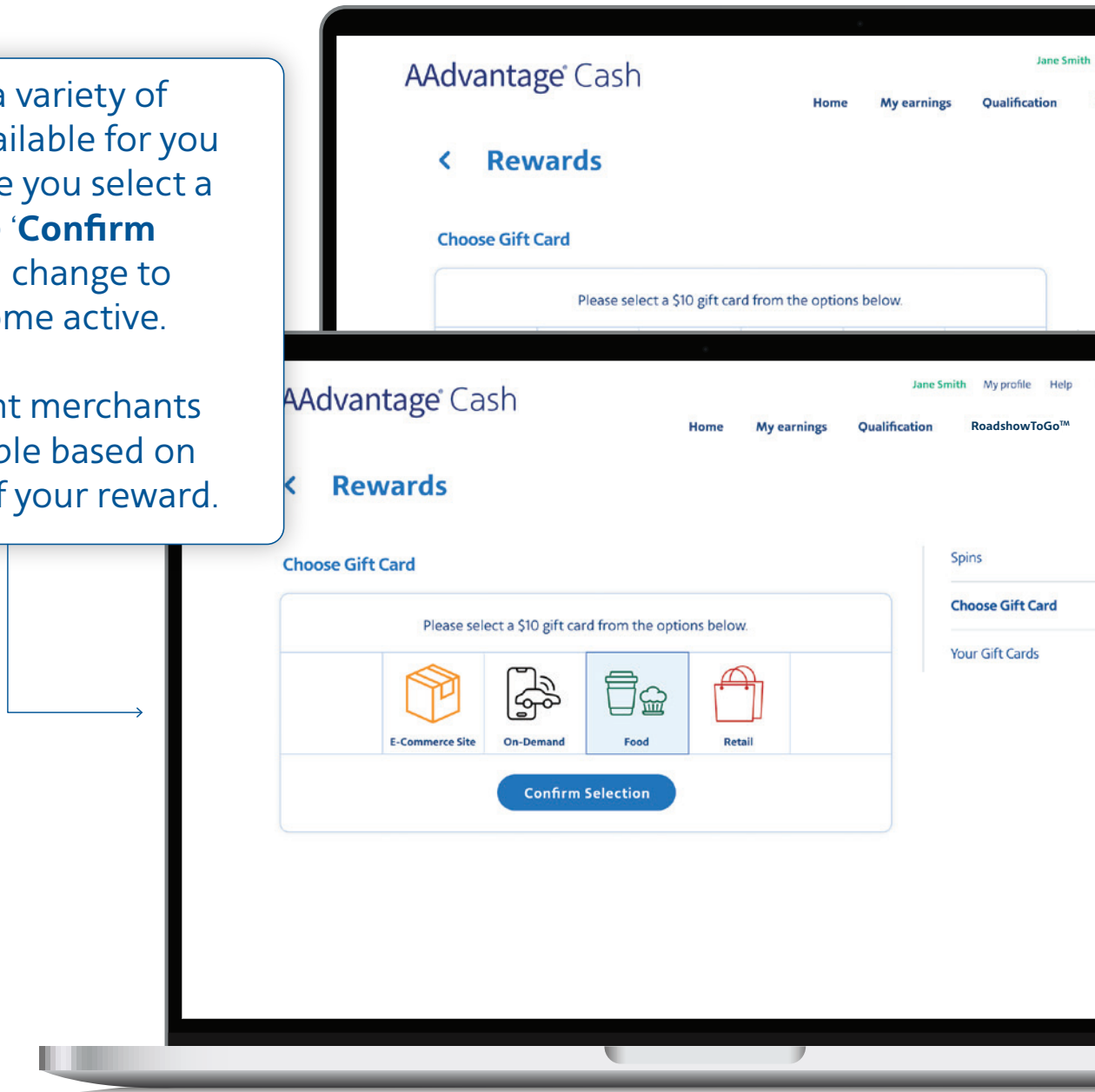

How to Choose Your Gift Card – Selecting a Merchant

There will be a variety of merchants available for you to select. Once you select a merchant, the '**Confirm Selection**' will change to blue and become active.

After clicking '**Confirm Selection**', you'll automatically navigate to the '**Your Gift Cards**' tab and see a success message.

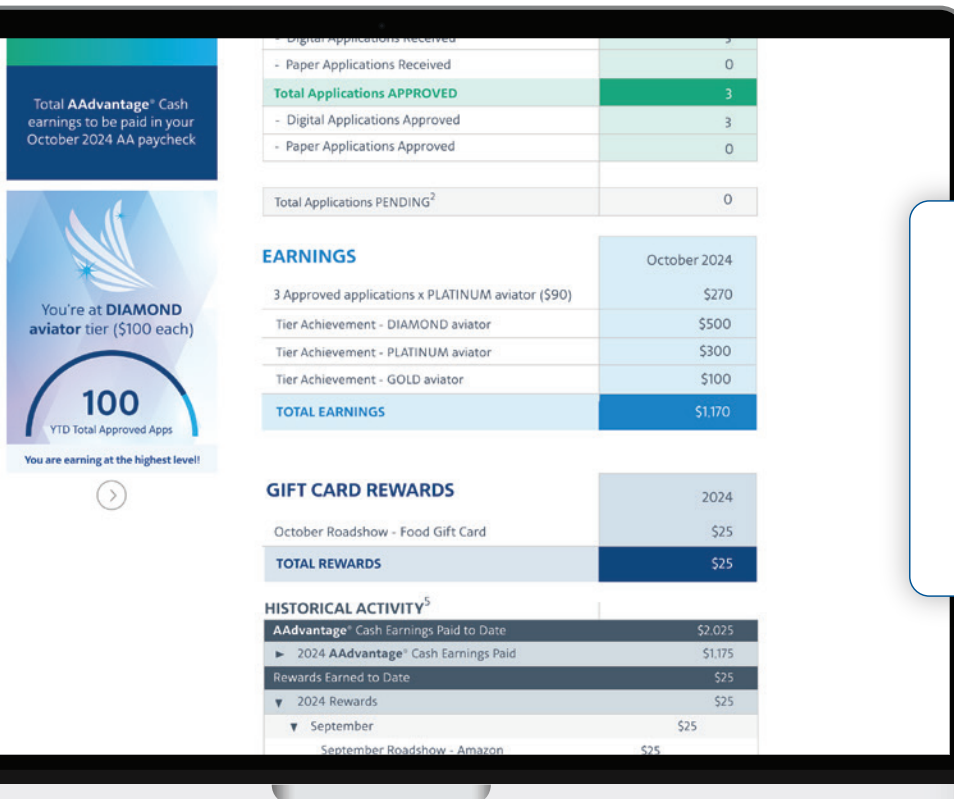
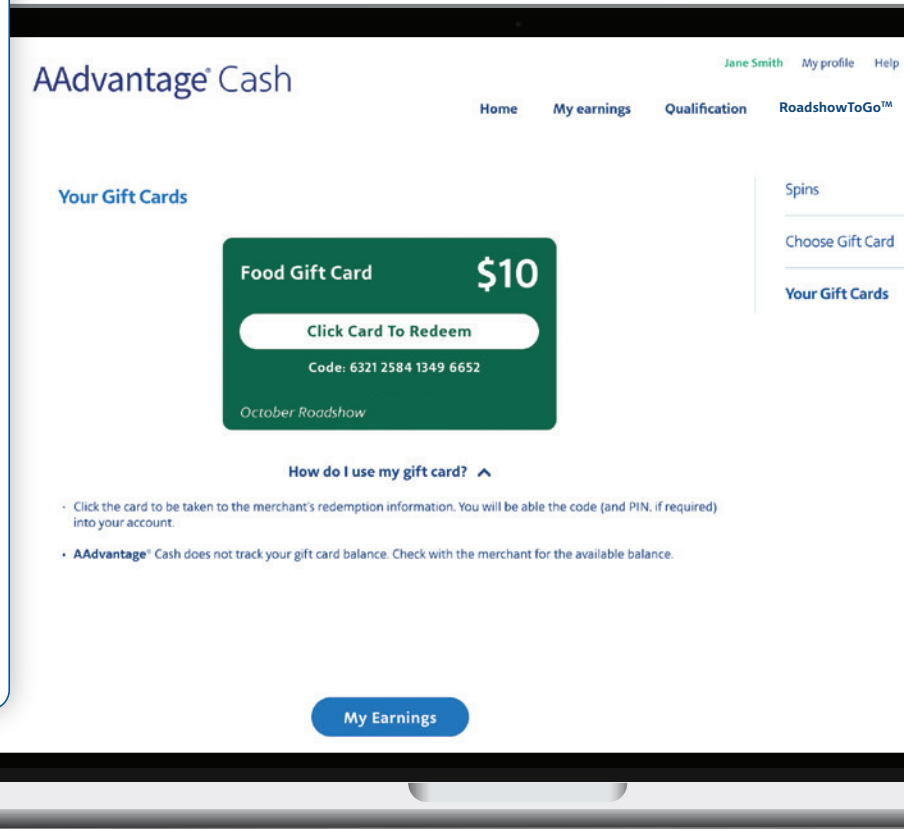

How to Redeem Your Gift Card


Your gift card will be listed under '**Your Gift Cards.**' The code and PIN (if required) will be displayed on the gift card. Click on '**Tap Card to Redeem**' to redeem your card on the merchant's website. The redemption process may vary depending on the merchant.

Your code and PIN (if required) are also available in an email in case you need to refer to them later.



Click '**My earnings**' to navigate to the My earnings page. As soon as you choose your gift card, the amount of your redeemed gift card will be displayed under '**Gift Card Rewards**'.

How to Remove a Gift Card





1. Open **'Your Gift Cards'** tab and check you have added your rewards to your merchant account.




